You must have called the wrong number.

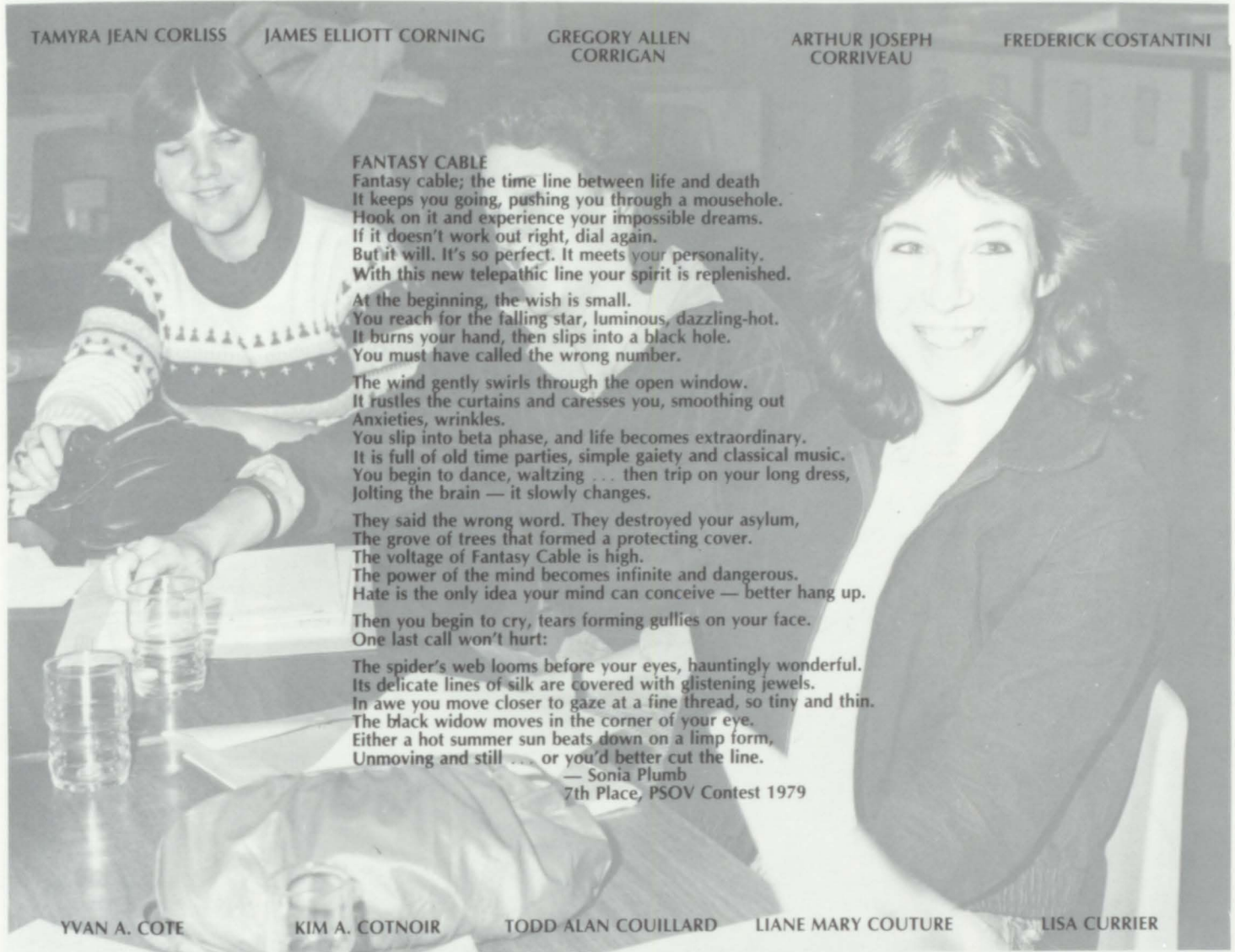
The wind gently swirls through the open window.

With whom we've laughed and cried.

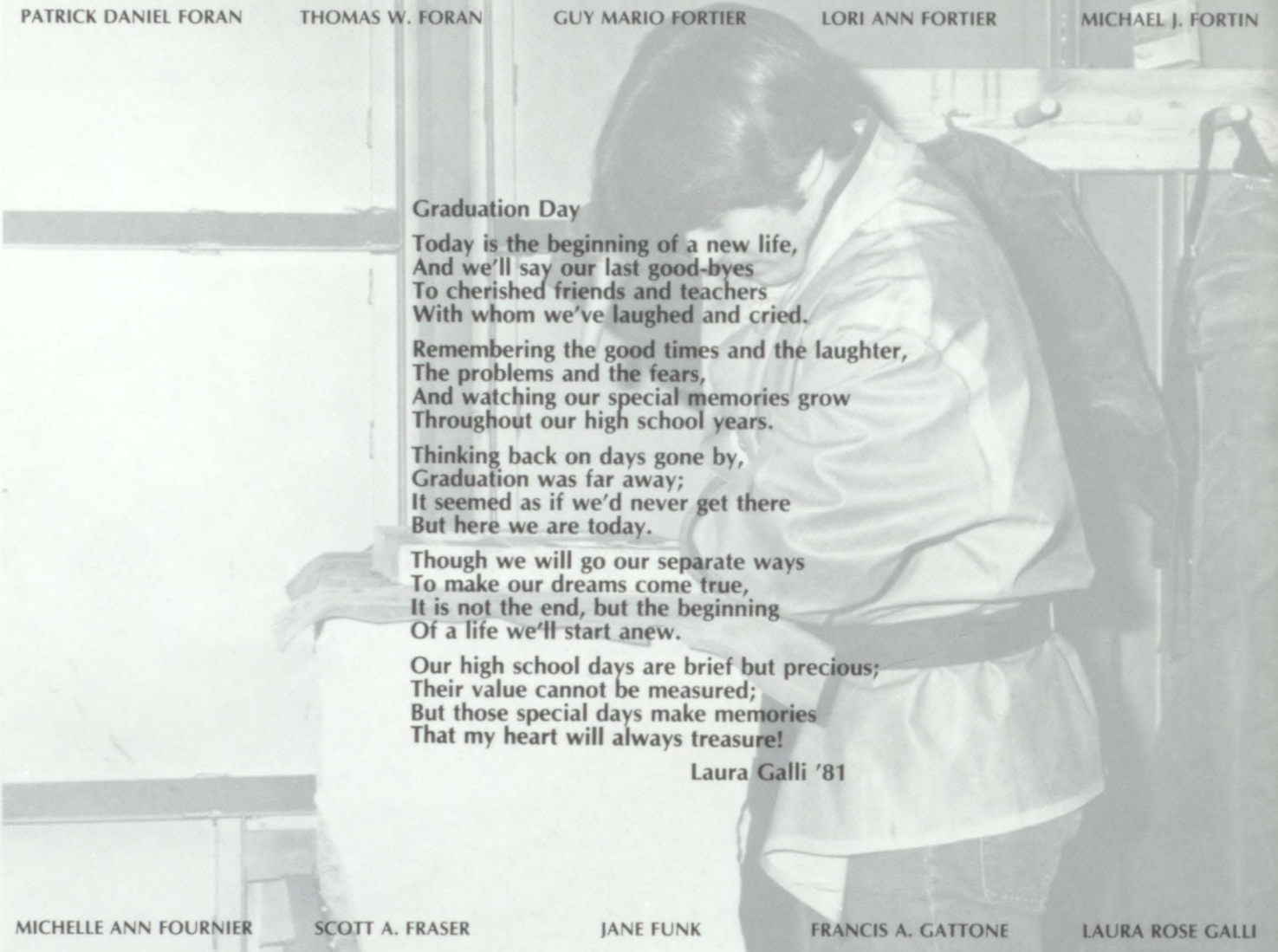
Remembering the good times and the laughter,

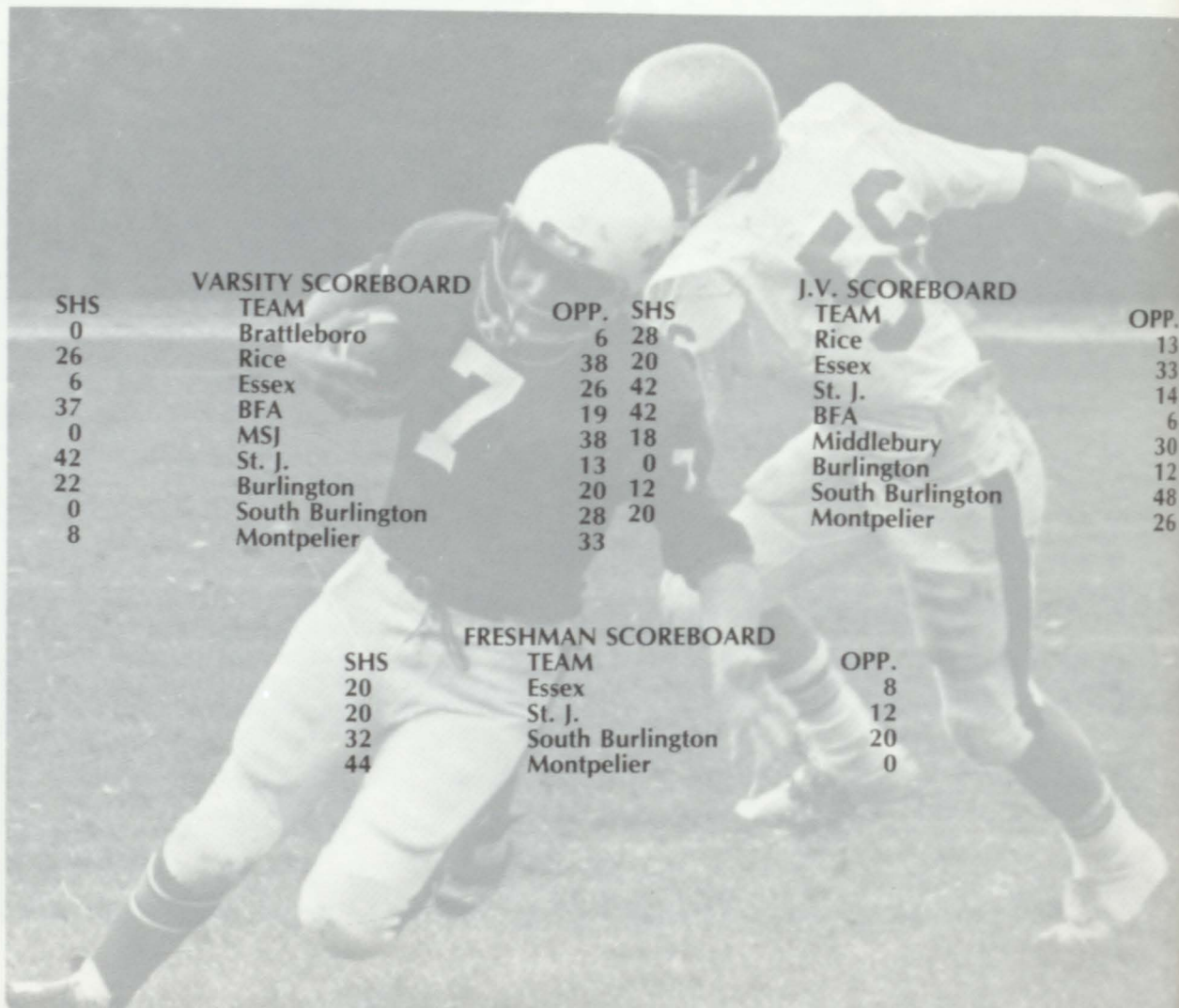
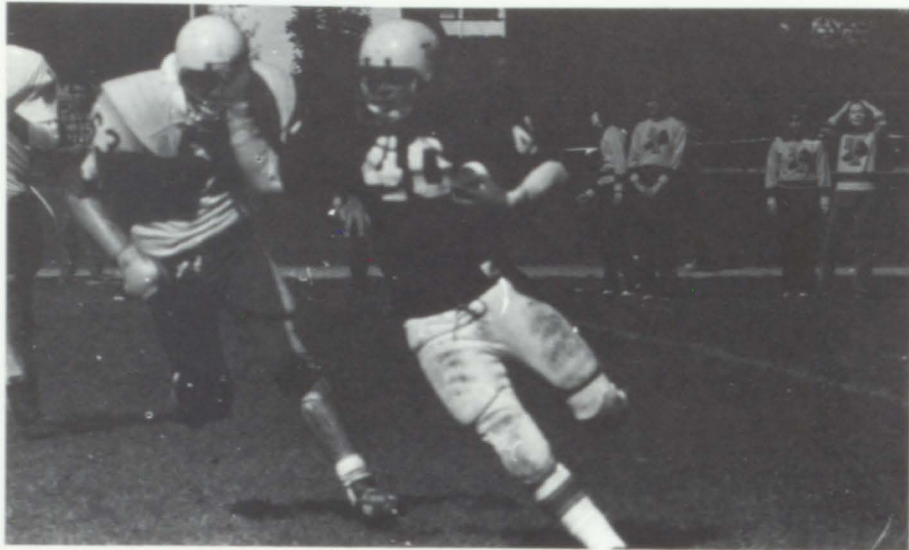
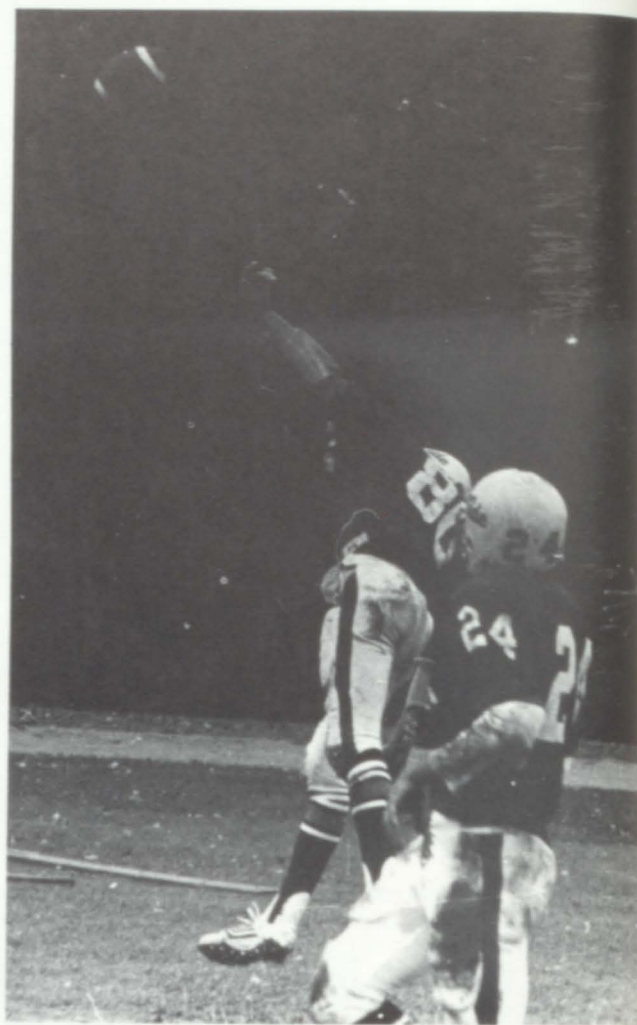
However, there were some bright spots. Through most of the season the Tide had the #1 running game in the division. Todd Martel led the league in rushing for six games, finishing third in the league.

CLASS PROPHECY



Scott Fitts chases criminals in the crime-ridden streets of Los Angeles. And the List goes on:


Julie Tidd has executive power over the United States of America, only second to our president, Chuck Williams.


Tim Jenness has aspired to managing editorship of the CBS Evening News. He's not the on-camera person, though — this job belongs to Lori Booth.


Steve Nelson has supplanted Richard Leaky as most popular archeologist in a recent poll by "People" magazine, editor Penny Hamilton reports.
