President's Report - Jan Albers

In my first letter as president, I welcome you to our Annual Report, and I am happy to tell you that we have met and surpassed our goals this year. I offer thanks to my esteemed predecessor in the role, Crocker Bennett, for his help in showing me the ropes since my election last October.

This was a strategic planning year for the Vermont Historical Society. Planning years (one in every five) entail a lot of work, but they are exciting and inspirational. Taking our previous plan, covering 2019-2024, as the basis for revisions, board members interviewed stakeholders, Steve Perkins and the staff brainstormed, and we all attended a board planning retreat. Our new strategic plan, covering 2024-2029, was approved in February and can be read on the VHS website. I came out of the process with a renewed belief that VHS is one of the greatest state historical societies in America — small but mighty.

The past year has not been without challenges. In Vermont, the Covid years seem to have given way to an era of annual “hundred year” floods, closing our Vermont History Museum in Montpelier for three months. Executive Director Stephen Perkins and the staff did an exemplary job of leading us through it all.

I am always amazed by how our brave little staff moves mountains. In addition to restoring operations, they managed to carry out their parts of the mission. Outreach continued via member publications and our many online venues. Books were catalogued, collections were preserved and refined, the buildings were maintained, digital services broadened our reach, and events were held for old and new friends.

Our latest exhibit, *For the Love of Vermont: The Lyman Orton Collection*, provides a public peek at 81 Vermont paintings from a premiere private collection. The opening on June 27 was a great

success, with 115 people crowding the galleries. It will be on display until the end of December.

Vermont History Day came back to pre-Covid levels on April 6, with 300 kids packing the Davis Center at UVM. Director Eileen Corcoran and her team pulled off this logistical maze with great finesse. It is hard to know who enjoyed it more—the students or the judges. We often hear about a school’s athletes, but as a former (and present) history nerd, I am touched by students who have caught the history research bug. They jump for joy when they get prizes, too. We sent 45 deserving winners to the National History Day in Maryland, where they appeared on CBS Sunday Morning!

One of the year’s highlights was our Vermont Eats dinner, this time featuring the history, food, and culture of Burlington’s Jewish community at the Ohavi Zedek Synagogue in the Old North End. Emily Lev, our new Director of Stewardship and Public Relations, and Eileen Corcoran, worked with the Synagogue and members of the Lost Mural Project, who have preserved a work of early-20th C. Jewish art that is housed there. Over 100 people came to the dinner, cooked by Ohavi Zedek volunteers. We learned about Jewish immigration to Vermont and the Lost Mural while enjoying music and delicious food. The program even included many wonderful recipes.

VHS publications have had a very successful year, with the launch of Mercedes de Guardiola’s book *Vermont for the Vermonters: The History of*



Our VHS family lost one of its most valued members on March 7, with the passing of Sarah Dopp of South Burlington. She inherited her interest in history, and her devotion to the VHS, from her parents, throwing herself into a great swath of activities here from the late-1970s until the time of her death. Sarah loved history, lifelong learning, sharing stories, and gifting meaningful family heirlooms to our collections. She served in a variety of roles on the board, as a committee chair, officer, and president over 32 years, from 1990 onward. In 2018, we gave her the rare honor of making her a lifetime trustee. In being always around and eager to help wherever she was needed, she came to be a part of the history of the VHS itself. It is hard to imagine Sarah not being here, and yet that is what we must do now. She will be here as long as there are people who knew her and all she meant to us.

History is always happening, and the Covid epidemic changed us all forever. Amanda Gustin, Director of Collections and Access, is determined that those experiences are not lost. She is leading an in-house oral history project that will create a moving permanent record of what real Vermonters went through in those stressful times. The Vermont Folklife Center is partnering with us in recording interviews of Vermonters from around the state. Expect the book in March 2025.

The VHS continues to enjoy solid finances this year. The three months of programming income we lost due to the flooding was largely made up by our great success in procuring grants. Jennifer Blair, Director of Finance and Operations, has done a wonderful job of transitioning the institution to updated, more user-friendly software and continues to add other improvements.

If this letter is long, it's because of all we have accomplished in the past year, despite the floods. I want to commend Steve Perkins for his exemplary leadership, the board for their wise guidance, and the staff for stepping up and keeping everything going forward. We are always grateful to the Governor and Legislature, whose financial support for Vermont history is substantial and unwavering. And we couldn't do any of it without our devoted members, patrons, donors, and visitors. Vermont history is for everyone. Thanks to all of you for being a part of this special organization.

Director's Report - Steve Perkins

July 2023 started out with great promise. A sunny and pleasant July 3rd celebration brought hundreds of visitors to the Vermont History Museum to kick off our exhibition season. A fascinating exhibit, inspired by graphic novels, told the story of Calvin Coolidge's life and career in celebration of the 100th anniversary of his inauguration as President of the United States. Plans were afoot to upgrade the Civil War gallery, and new staff were just settling into their roles.

One week later, our operations were upended and our communities of Barre and Montpelier devastated by flooding. Thanks to lessons learned after the 1992 Montpelier flood, the Vermont Historical Society's collections remained safe, secure, and dry in the hillside Vermont History Center. Water came perilously close to reaching the raised, first-floor location of the Vermont History Museum before receding. The damage to the Pavilion Building was profound, and though the museum contents were safe, our public face remained closed throughout the summer and fall tourist season. Images of our building with plastic sheeting, pump hoses, and temporary air ducts were flashed around the country leading to calls and notes of support from Vermonters and museum colleagues from around the world. As an organization, we weathered the storm and continued to provide the content, advice, and support our public and peers expected. In this report, you will see a large earned-revenue shortfall due to the museum closure during peak tourist season, and we thank all of you who increased your philanthropic support to help bridge this gap.

Throughout the remaining months of 2023, staff, board members, donors, and community members spent time reflecting on Vermont Historical Society's strengths, accomplishments, and opportunities for growth in formulating a new five-year strategic plan. As part of this process, the board gave some serious thought to the mission

of our organization and decided to rephrase the basis of our work in a way that makes our impact statement the first idea we present: Vermont Historical Society believes understanding the past changes lives and builds better communities.

We crafted a plan that continues much of the good work we have been doing for almost a decade and adds strategies asked for by our patrons and our field and necessitated by the changing world around us. Our goals look outward in meeting people where they are, supporting communities of learners, inspiring students and the next generation of historians, and assisting our colleagues in local societies throughout the state. Internally we look forward to breaking down barriers to access our incredible holdings and making our physical locations exciting, beautiful, and easy to navigate. I encourage you to visit our website and read the summary plan for yourself. How do you want to be involved?

None of this could be possible without our engaged board and our hardworking and committed staff. Thank you all for your ongoing support – this past year was trying, but, with your help, we proved our resilience. With your continued engagement and participation, I look forward to great things to come.

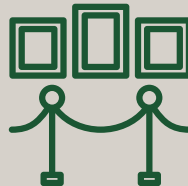

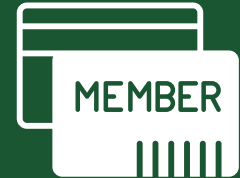
Enrich guests' experience through deeper understanding of Vermont and its people.
