natives among those of foreign parentage than among those of native parentage, but this is due in part to the relatively small number of native white persons of foreign parentage in these two divisions as compared with their large native white population of native parentage, and in part to the fact that this element of foreign parentage has come into these divisions from the more northerly states where their parents, who are themselves of foreign birth, were living when they were born.

From table LXVI (page cxxxiv) it appears that there are 13,528,095 persons living in the several states and territories in 1900 who were born in some other state or territory, and a distribution of this number of persons is made in detail by states and territories in table LXVII, showing, for each state and territory, the number of residents who were born in the different states and

territories and the proportion which this number, in each case, bears to the total native born population of the state or territory under consideration. In brief, this table shows the states which have contributed to any extent to the native born population of any state or territory, and is easily understood. For illustration, there are 37,094 persons living in Maine who were born elsewhere in the United States, and constituting 6.2 per cent of the entire native born population of that state in 1900. Of this number Massachusetts has contributed 15,145 persons, equivalent to 2.5 per cent of all the native born in Maine, and, similarly, New Hampshire has contributed 8,902 persons, New York 3,170 persons, and Vermont 1,969 persons, in addition to the contributions from other states specified in the table.

division 1,368,957 such persons, leaving a little more than a million to be divided between the two Atlantic divisions.

Leaving out of consideration the native migration which has taken place within each geographical division, it appears that the North Atlantic division has 1,938,890 natives living in the other divisions of the country and that 1,354,636 of these are living in the North Central division and 325,527 in the Western division.

The South Atlantic division, also, has a large number of natives living beyond its limits, comprising, in all, 1,372,186 persons. The South Central division has received much the largest contribution, namely, 651,259, while the Western division has received only 62,288, leaving the remainder to be very nearly evenly divided between the North Atlantic and North Central divisions.

Although the North Central division has received large contributions from the other divisions, it has also made a large contribution to the native population of the other divisions, but principally to the Western and South Central divisions. The total number of natives of the North Central division living in other divisions in 1900 is 1,864,559, and of this number 858,420 are in the Western division and 661,684 in the South Central division.

This large contribution to the South Central division is very nearly balanced by the contribution made by that division to the North Central division, representing a total of 602,168, and constituting more than two-thirds of its entire contribution to the other divisions.

The Western division has contributed only a small number of its natives to the other divisions, and this has been made principally to the North Central division.

A comparison of the figures for 1900 with similar figures contained in the summary for 1890 shows that

the divisions to which the bulk of the natives of the several divisions have gone contained usually larger proportions in 1890 than in 1900, and so it is undoubtedly true that if a similar analysis were made for some of the earlier censuses the figures would be even more strongly indicative of the great volume of native migration to the different sections of the country which occurred during the earlier periods of settlement.

The varying proportions of resident natives, native immigrants, and foreign born in the several states and territories in 1900, together with the proportion of native emigrants in each case, are shown graphically by the diagram on plate 16.

Table LXXII shows the states and territories to which each state or territory has contributed of its numbers most largely, and is, in effect, a detailed presentation for each state and territory of the present location of its "native emigrants" who are still living within the limits of the United States. In this table the whole number of natives of the state or territory who are living in other states and territories is taken as 100 per cent, so that a casual inspection of the table will show for any state or territory the respective proportions which it has contributed to the states and territories in which its natives are principally found. For illustration, the table shows for Maine that there are 216,551 natives of that state living in other states and territories in 1900, and that of this number 98,375, or very nearly one-half of all its native emigrants, are living in Massachusetts. It also shows the other states which contain considerable numbers of natives of Maine, as, for instance, 16,650 in New Hampshire, 14,732 in California, 10,654 in Minnesota, and so on.

CITIZENSHIP, AND YEARS IN THE UNITED STATES.
