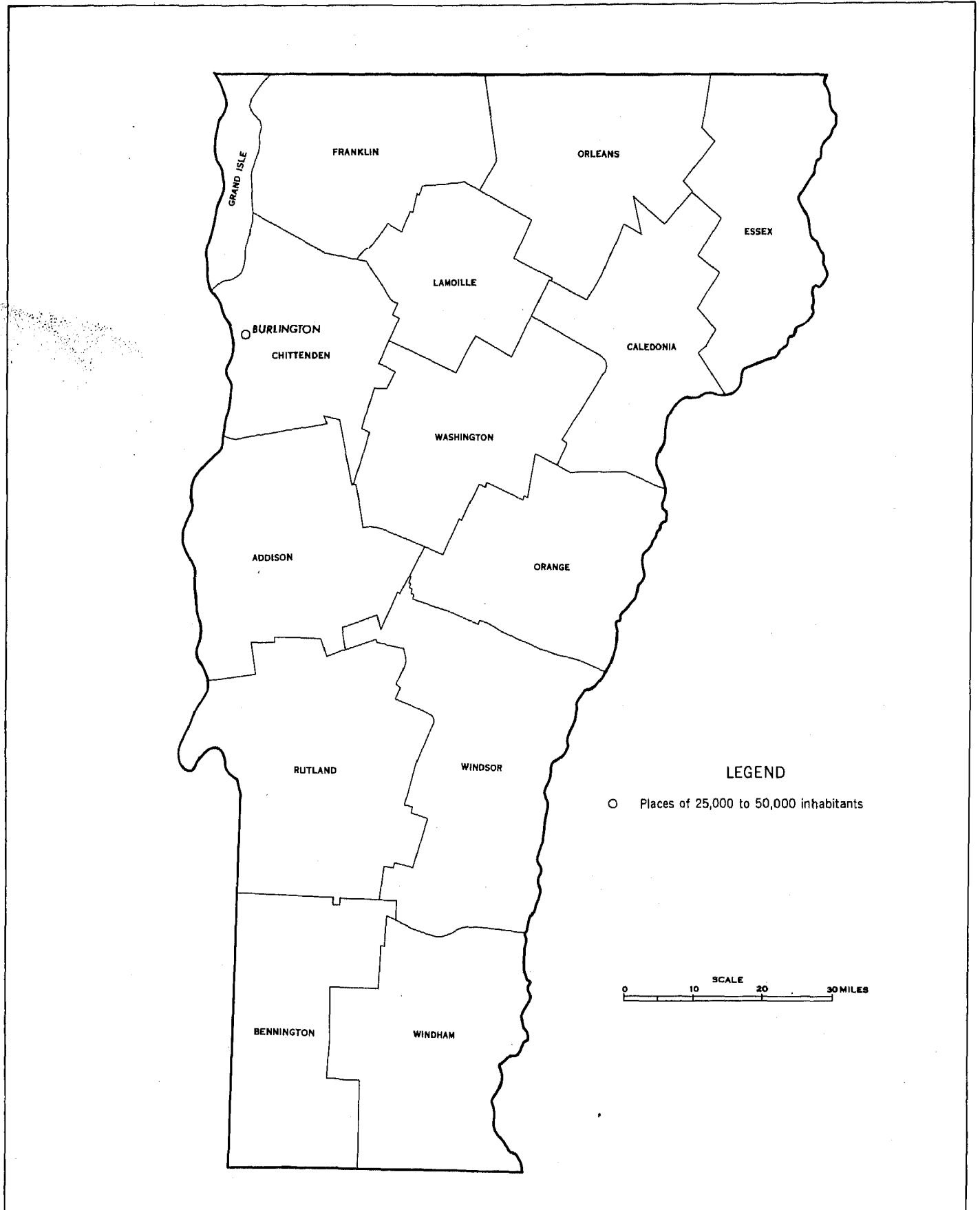

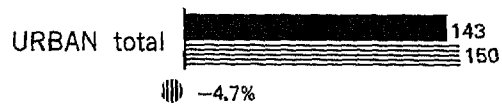
Number of Inhabitants 1970 and 1960

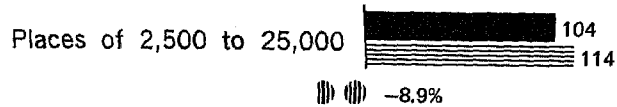
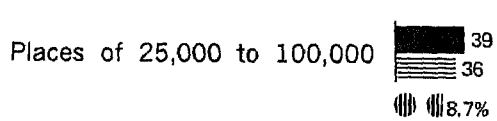

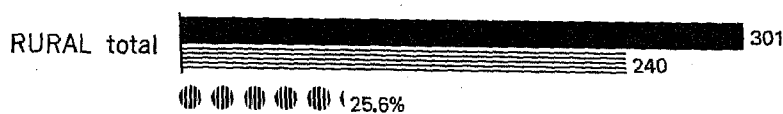
URBAN and RURAL RESIDENCE



Places of 100,000 or more (NONE)



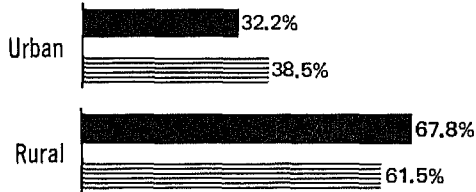

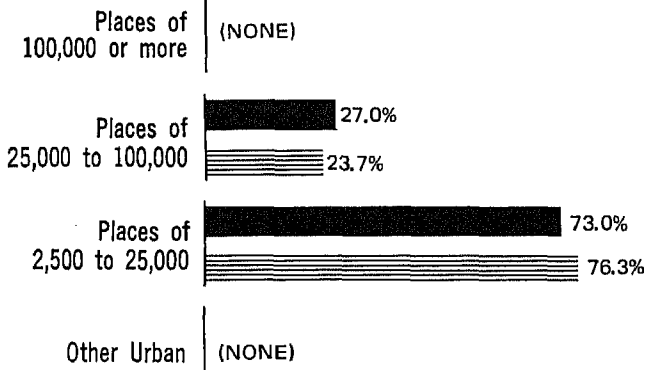
**Percent Distribution

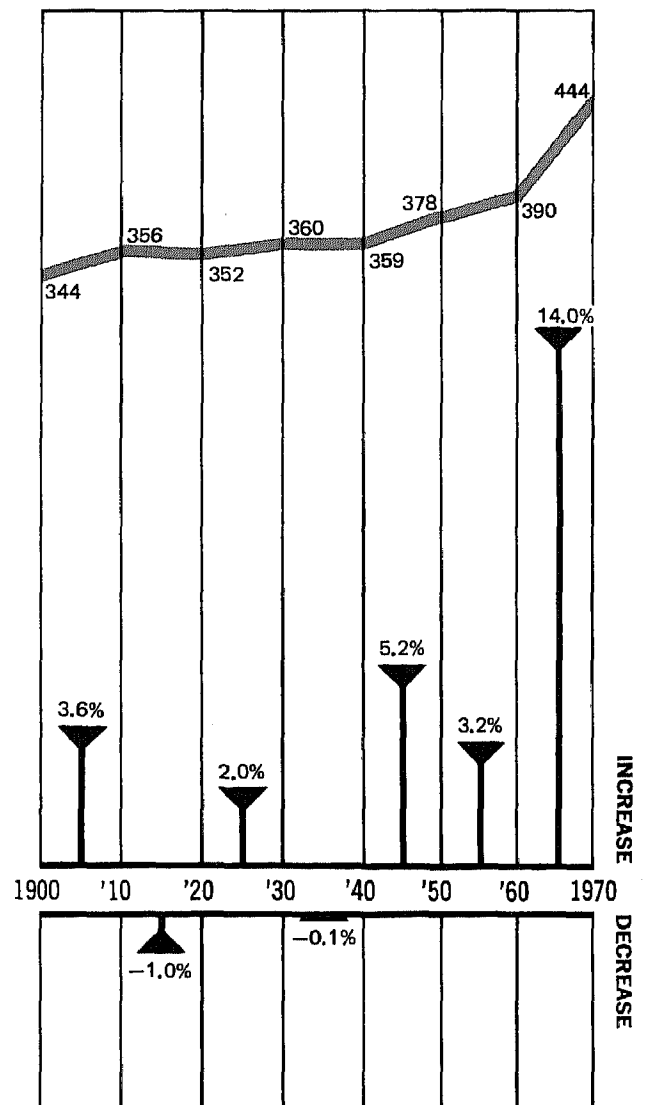

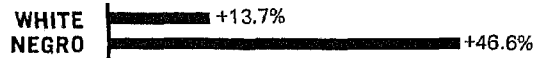

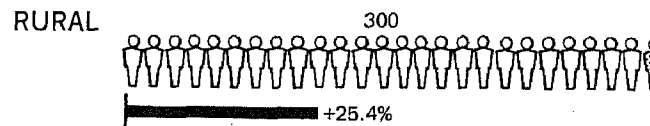
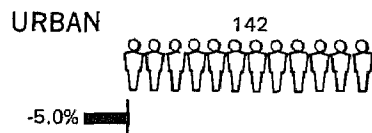

(SMSA's=Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas)

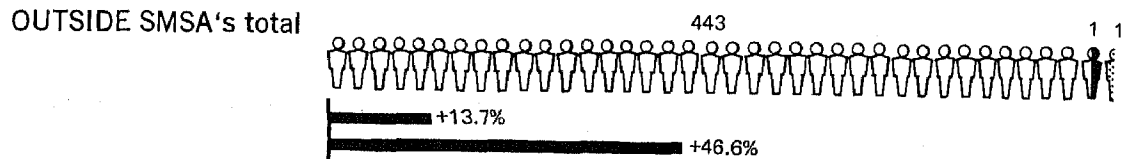

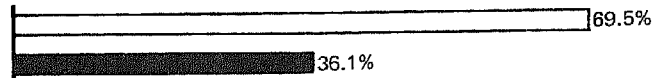

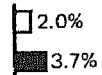

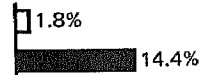

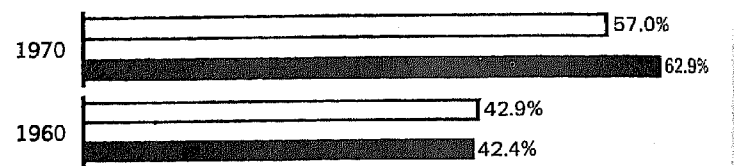

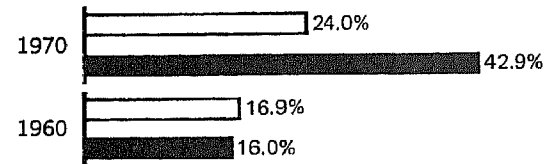

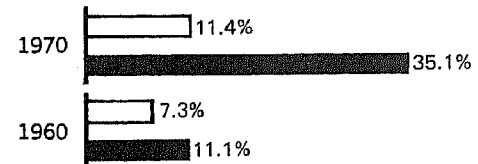

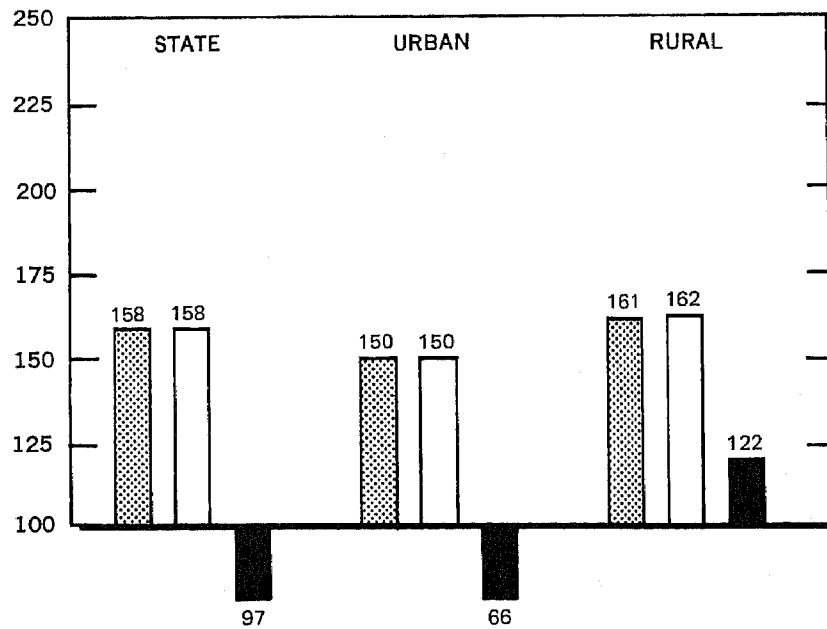

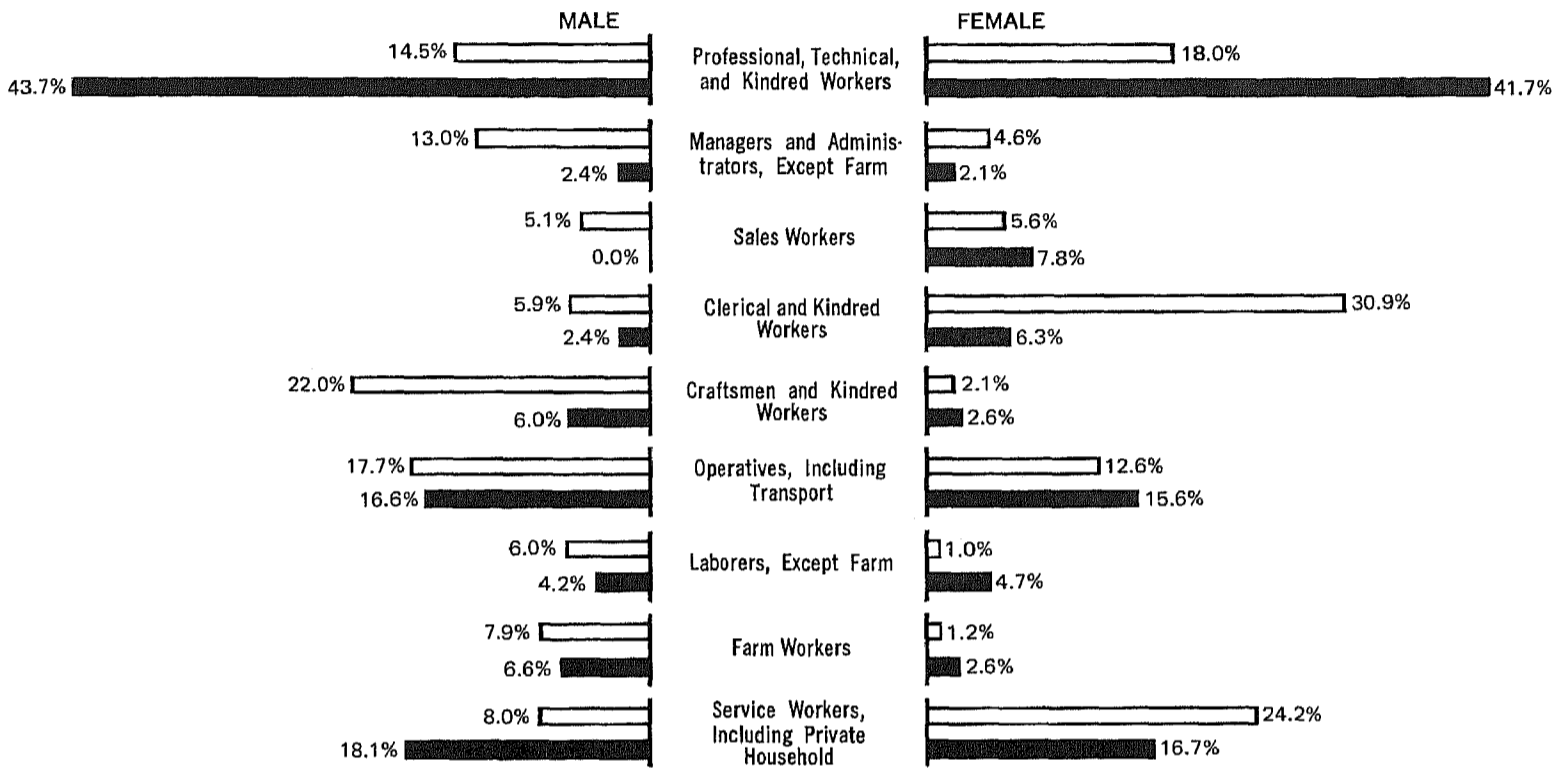
POPULATION REPLACEMENT INDEX: 1970

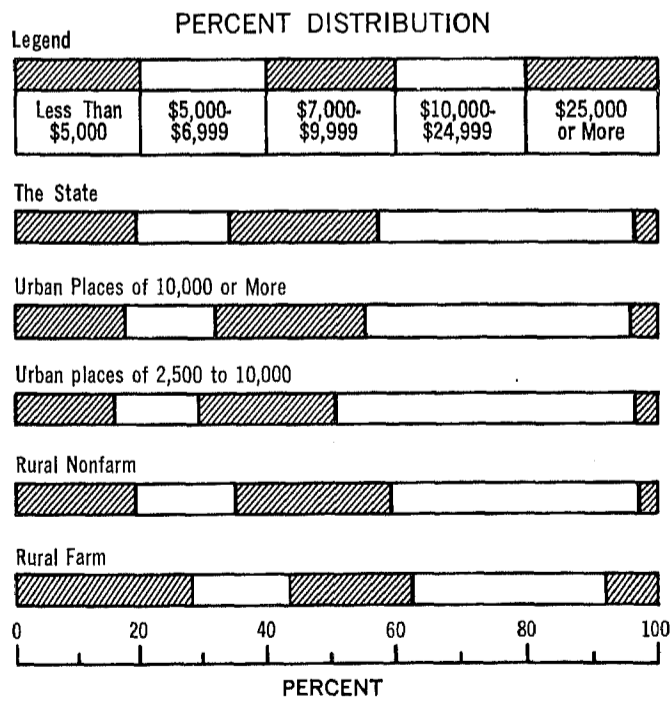

 PERCENT of SELECTED POPULATION GROUPS

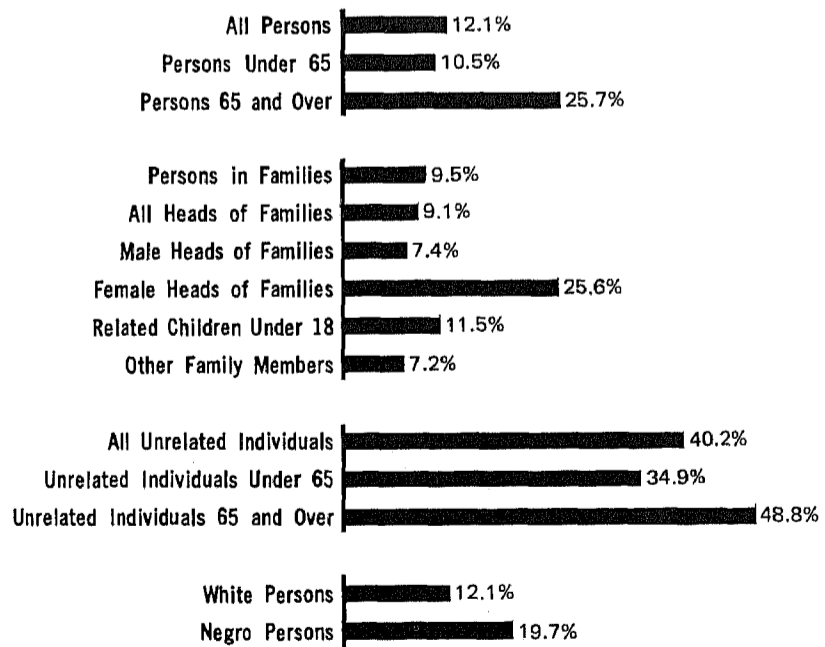
